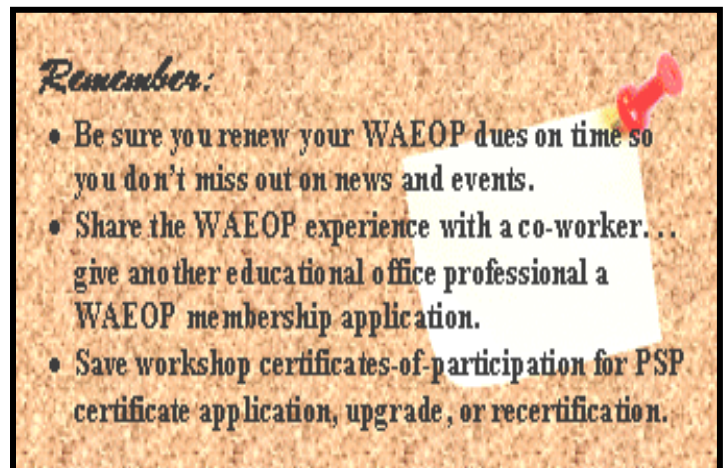
The mission of the Washington Association of Educational Office Professionals is to promote the professional standards of our diverse membership through networking, information, and education.

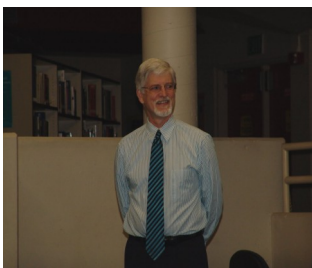
## What an Impact! . . .
